Botanical Gardens ‘warms your wallet’ with “50 at 50”—hot news for cool weather!

As easy as glancing at your cell phone, you can enjoy the entire South Texas Botanical Gardens & Nature Center, for 50 percent off, IF you arrive when the temperature is at or below 50 degrees Fahrenheit, during “50 at 50”, now through March 31!

A quick phone weather app check at the Visitors Center front desk closes the deal, for half off all levels of general admission, not valid with other offers. That means just \$4 adults; \$3 seniors at 60 / active Military / college students; \$1.50 ages three through 12.

The Orchid Conservatory, Bromeliad Conservatory, Prentiss Butterfly Collection in Education Station, plus Resident Reptiles and Nature’s Boutique in the Visitors Center already are warm indoor venues. “But a crisp, cool stroll through other exhibits and nature areas can yield sightings of wildlife not seen during warmer weather,” says Executive Director Michael Womack. “You can take an invigorating hike down the nature trails and wetland boardwalk without breaking a sweat,” he quipped.

Located at 8545 S. Staples St., the Botanical Gardens & Nature Center is open 9 to 6 daily, with special “Parrot Talk” visitor interactive presentations offered at 1:30 pm each Friday, Saturday and Sunday, included in admission.
