Entry fees, last changed in 2012, still a bargain!

Botanical Gardens & Nature Center general admission has not increased since May, 2012! Meanwhile, the new Samuel Jones Orchid Conservatory, Education Station with classroom and Prentiss Global Butterfly Exhibit, Tropical Garden, Resident Reptiles, Exotic Parrots and Monkey Mansion Tree House have been added! Additionally, Nature's Boutique gift shop was remodeled and expanded when administrative staff moved into the new Administrative facility.

So increasing adult and children's admission \$1 is still a terrific bargain. Senior, active Military and college student admission remains the same. Your Botanical Gardens membership, which includes free admission and national gardens reciprocal program—becomes more valuable when new admission prices take effect October 1.
